On an attempt to open the .oxgz project file, the "Encountered an improper argument" error message is displayed and the file is not opened.



Possible Reasons

• Your file name or the name of the folder where it is stored has characters in a language different from the Windows Format and Current system locale regional settings.

How to Solve

Should be in the same language:

- Characters in your file name or the name of the folder(s) (full path) where it is stored
- Windows Format setting
- Windows Current system locale setting

To configure that:

- 1. In your Windows settings, find Region. The Region dialog is displayed.
- 2. In the Region dialog, use the Formats tab.
- 3. Set Format to the language in correspondence with your file/folder name.
