

How to use DM software in the interlaced stereo mode

The following settings are located in the **NVIDIA Control Panel**. To open the panel you should click right mouse button on the desktop and select the appropriate option from the context menu. Also you can find it in the **Control Panel**.

If you want to use **DM** application over the 3D TV with interlaced stereo (passive glasses), please follow these steps.

Step-by-step guide

Disable stereoscopic 3D (NVIDIA GeForce/Quadro)

1. Click on the **Set up stereoscopic 3D** (**Stereoscopic 3D** section from the left side);
2. Uncheck **Enable stereoscopic 3D**;
3. Click on the **Apply** button.

Disable windowed stereo (NVIDIA Quadro only)

1. Click on **Manage 3D settings** (**3D Settings** section from the left side);
2. Click on **Stereo - Enable** and select **Off** (only for **DM** software or in the **Global Settings** section);
3. Click on the **Apply** button.

After that, if you run the **DM** application, it will be started with supporting of the interlaced stereo.



Notes:

- For scaling the frame, activate the **Image Fit Mode** (Alt + T).
- If the **DM** GUI font size is too small for the current display resolution (for example, when you use **Ultra HD 4K**), or the GUI text is difficult to read in the interlaced stereo mode, please activate the bold font in the application (for details see: [How to activate bold font in the DM software GUI](#)).
